**New business:**

**Goals for the SACG for 2006-2007:**

- 1. The Guild will participate in sponsoring an art auction as long as we can afford it. We would offer manual labor and would get part of the profit. This was voted on and passed.**
- 2. The Artists and Crafters Show will be held at the Library in October. There is a question about where it should be held in 2007 due to the increase in size of the show. Volunteers will be needed to assist the judges this year. Barb has already volunteered.**
- 3. It was suggested that the Holiday Bazaar be held at the Scott Club, but it is not certain who will look into that until we have an Activities Chairman.**
- 4. It has been suggested that we have speakers, show and tell and quarterly potlucks at our meetings as well as field trips.**
- 5. A SACG website was suggested.**

6. **A static display of SACG members' work is to be displayed at the Library monthly. Several pieces of artwork as well as a photo and bio of the artist is to be displayed. The contact point is Sandy at the Library. Barb, Shirley and Katie will work on this.**

**Molly gave a show and tell of her jewelry hangers which she had created.  
Susan showed us her socks that she was knitting.**
