

**SCOTT ARTISTS AND CRAFTERS GUILD
FEBRUARY MEETING MINUTES
FEBRUARY 7, 2006**

The meeting was called to order at 6:01 p.m. Minutes from the January meeting were read, approved and seconded.

Treasurer's report: In January dues of \$3.50 were collected from both Candace and Dee and Molly returned \$2.17 which was left over from the Artists and Crafters Show for a \$9.17 income to the SACG account. There was an outgoing amount of \$30 to the secretary for paper and ink. The current account total is \$169.97.

Membership report: There were two new members in January; Candace McKay and Dee Morgan.

Programs report: Katie made fliers for the Spring Arts and Crafts Fair. Molly took some for distribution.

Activities report: Molly was absent from the meeting.

Publicity report: SACG membership information is being distributed through email, base paper, a poster in the A&CC, fliers and the A&CC marquis.

Old business:

Unless we have too many vendors, we should be able to have vendor tables set up inside of the A&CC for the Spring Arts and Crafts Fair. (SACF) There will be a chart centrally located showing where vendors are located within (or without if necessary) the building. The SACG will have a table at the SACF in order to hand out information and answer any questions concerning the Guild. The SACF will be held on Saturday, March 4th from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. We are in need of volunteers to work the Guild table. Mike has volunteered for 2 to 5 p.m. Please notify Barb asap of the times you are able to help so that a schedule can be made. It was also voted on and passed that there would be a drawing at the SACG table for a \$10 certificate to the A&C Center's Sale Store. The winner will be notified by a SACG member and need not be present to win.

It was voted on, seconded and passed that the SACG secretary will be allowed to submit receipts for any supplies that are needed for that position, specifically paper

and ink, and that the secretary will be reimbursed by the Guild. At present the Guild has almost a whole ream of paper on hand for secretarial use.

New business:

Gary has received an email concerning a youth photography contest. The Guild has been asked if it can supply any judges for this contest. Five are needed. The contest will be held from April 10th to 12th with an exhibitor entry deadline of April 5th. Gary, Mike, Katie and Barb have thus far volunteered to help. Gary will let us know the actual location and date of the judging as well as who will be chosen for judges. More volunteers are needed in case some of the above do not meet the requirements to be a judge.

Gary also told us that the Air Force held a conference in which it has decided to have Air Force- wide art and craft shows. This will affect our fall Scott Artists and Crafters Show by backing it up at least a month to sometime in October rather than November. The Air Force will be setting guidelines for these shows although how that will affect our show is not available at this time.

Show and Tell:

Katie gave us a great demonstration of Russian Needle Punch. Thanks, Katie.
