Old Business:

A. Art Show:

- 1. We discussed some suggestions for the Art Show next year. They included:**
 - a. Boxes, bags, etc. that are used by an artisan to deliver his/her artwork must be clearly labeled, and the artisan needs to note on his/her entry form if the packaging is to be retrieved.**
 - b. We will not be able to subdivide categories any more than they are already divided.**
 - c. We need to stress more that objects must be delivered ready to display, especially things that will need to hang.**
 - d. If winners are awarded coupons, they should not have to have the entire booklet to redeem a coupon. The coupons should be individualized.**
 - e. When artwork is brought to the library for the set-up, someone should be assigned to read off the name to the person checking in the artwork while a third person should deliver the item to the area where it will be displayed instead of everything being piled in one area.**
 - f. We should provide a table cover for Chick-Fil-A because their cover is too small. Also, I will send them a thank-you card for their contribution.**
 - g. We need to be stricter about pieces being placed in the proper category (e.g., framed batik should be in Textiles, not in Painting).**
 - h. Clarify "prizes".**
 - i. Clarify categories, e.g. Drawing/Pastels, so that those items wouldn't be put into a Painting category.**
 - j. When art pieces such as a photo are dropped off at the Arts and Crafts center, they need to be checked to make sure they have proper hangers.**
 - k. Pieces in sets should be able to be sold separately, at the discretion of the artisan.**
 - l. On a happy note, we did not have to pay for the panels this year.**

New Business:
