- A. Jesse is PCSing, someone else will need to take pictures for the guild. He is willing to keep up the website; we just need to send any information to him.
- B. Claudia will be the Arts and Crafts Center featured artist for October.
- C. Claudia opened a discussion: What benefit is there in being a member of the guild? We talked about the advantage of displaying your pieces in the library (could lead to sales), but mainly it's the social aspect of the guild that we enjoy now. We talked about trying to get more members, possibly sponsoring guild members for \$1 off if they take a class at the A&C Center. We could have different people in to talk about common interests, such as arranging your pieces for display, small business concerns, copyright issues, etc. Claudia thought the person speaking could even bring in any pieces of their own for sale.  
New members could get a hand-made mug when they join.

**We have a logo; we could look into getting a guild card.  
Jesse said it is rather easy to get your work featured in a magazine. He is featured in a woodworking magazine this month.**
